Treasurer's Report – by Bob Stocks

- Year-to-date as of 3/31/2015 balance sheet shared. We are ahead of budget because of extra members and lower-than-expected costs for pro/teachers.
- Checking balance: \$26,040.96, Savings – \$2017.28 for a total of \$28,058.24 with no outstanding liabilities.
- We have 385 members, five of which are from the Ranch.
- Bob was asked why the ending balance did not match the net worth. He will check.

Committee and Event Updates:

Socials - Debbie McGeehan

Cinco de Mayo 5/5 planning is underway with Joanie Dragon arranging the party. The 4th of July Chili Cook Off and Labor Day 9/7 socials still need volunteers to chair. Debbie will run Sadie Hawkins on 11/13 and the Christmas Dinner Dance on Dec 12th. John will organize the New Year's Eve Day 12/31 social. A volunteer recognition celebration will be announced sometime in November.

Club Championship - Joyce Wantuck

Championship underway. Instead of eliminating categories with fewer than three entries, they allowed them to do a two-out-of-three competition. TJ thanked that Wantucks, Carol Eisenbraun, Frank Valenti and Glenn George for all their work.

Jim Fabio suggested that we should have advertised this to the community to watch. They will try to get something in the Monday message and Saddlebrooke One events emails.

HOA Tennis Committees

- Riley, HOA2 Chair, reported that Desert View windscreens (to prevent glare on courts 14 & 15) are in the budget but need final approval by the HOA2 board to spend the money.
- Linda Depew, HOA1 Chair, reported that the west-facing, retractable sunscreen for the Tennis Center patio is scheduled for installation in late April. This was paid for by HOA1, and must be lowered and raised by the patrol for events.
- Courts 5 through 8 will be resurfaced in June.

Unfinished Business:

Court Reservation Change: TJ announced that on April 10 a trial begins to allow members to reserve courts in the third session of OP a week ahead much like non-members have the ability to do. An announcement with details and priorities will be sent to email subscribers and posted on the web.

Pickleball Rumor Control:

Rick reported that at the recent meeting of the HOA2 Tennis Committee Bill Einecker, President of HOA2 BODs, stated that the developer (RCI) recognizes the decline in tennis participation and the increase in pickleball participants, which has increased the demand for more pickleball courts. However, before addressing where additional courts might be located, a test is being conducted at the Preserve pickleball courts, requiring the use of quieter balls and paddles. Once this test is concluded, the location of any additional courts will be addressed.

Any discussion that might impact the number of tennis courts in HOA2 will involve consultation with the tennis community.

Jim Fabio submitted some suggestion for the board to consider.
